Our K-12 and postsecondary education providers support workforce needs with specialized training and continuing education. For example, Georgia Northwestern Technical College provides companies with workforce training and customized industrial and organizational development training onsite or at its campuses in Catoosa and Walker Counties. There are also specialized programs, including Mechatronics at the Catoosa County campus and Trucking at Walker County.

Through Georgia's Quick Start program, new and expanding companies can obtain customized workforce training at no cost, along with services including pre-employment screening, customized training plans, workplace safety training, and industrial skills training.

Work-based K-12 learning coordinators create a steady workforce pipeline by pairing students with potential employers and providing job-specific training while students are still in school.
